

STAGE TWO - HAMILTON CBD REVITALISATION

Council are designing improvements to some of Hamilton CBD streets and public spaces. The project was identified as part of the city-wide Hamilton Structure Plan prepared by Council in 2012.

The focus of stage two of the CBD revitalisation includes CBD concept designs for Melville Oval, Lonsdale Street and Gray Street, as well as other connecting streets.

Urban designers Jensen PLUS have been engaged to assist with the design stage and explore options to improve walking and cycling, introduce more public art and signage, better public spaces and parking, and improved trees and landscaping.

Workshops will be held at Shop 10 in the HUB Shopping Centre at 138 Gray Street. Community members are invited to visit the studio any time to review the designs:

- 1pm and 5pm on Thursday 21 February
- 9am and 5pm on Friday 22 February
- 9am and 1pm on Saturday 23 February

The consultants will also be holding a street walk around the Hamilton CBD on **Friday 22 February at 3pm**, leaving from the Hub in Gray Street.
