## HAMILTON OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOL TO OPEN

From Saturday 6 November the Hamilton Outdoor Swimming Pool will open from **3:00pm to 7:00pm seven days a week**, with the following exceptions:

- The pool will be closed when the air temperature forecast by the Bureau of Meteorology at 4:00pm for the next day is less than:-
  - 23 degrees Celsius for all unheated Pools.
  - 21 degrees Celsius for all heated Pools.
- The pool will open **12:00pm to 7:00pm** when the air temperature forecast by the Bureau of Meteorology at 4:00pm for the next day is more than 35 degrees Celsius (weekends and all of January only).

Outer township swimming pools are scheduled to open early December 2021, and all pools will close in March 2022.

## HENTY HWY AND SOUTH BOUNDARY ROAD INTERSECTION WORKS

Works will commence on **Monday 8 November 2021** to upgrade the intersection of Henty Highway and South Boundary Road Hamilton. This intersection forms part of the alternative heavy vehicle route around the Hamilton CBD, being implemented in the Cox Street Redevelopment Project. These strengthening works are required to be completed before the heavy vehicle detour of Cox Street can begin.

Reduced speed limits will be in place and the roads will be reduced to one lane during the day throughout the construction period. Works are expected to be complete in January 2022.
