

## GRAY STREET WORKS

### Cavendish Red Gum Festival

Permission has been granted to the Cavendish Red Gum Festival for the **temporary closure** of **Barker Street, Cavendish** from **Scott Street to Old Tannery Road** for the Red Gum Festival event being held on **Saturday 23 April 2022** between **9:00am to 7:00pm**.

### Anzac Day March and Parade - Hamilton

Permission has been granted to the Hamilton RSL Sub-Branch for an Anzac Day March and Parade on **Monday 25 April 2022** for the rolling **temporary closure** of the following streets:

- Gray Street, commencing from Kennedy Street at **9:30am**
- Turning left into Brown Street to Lonsdale Street roundabout,
- Turning right to the Vietnam Memorial in Fitzpatrick Gardens.

Following the Vietnam Memorial Service, marchers and spectators will be able to move freely along Melville Oval netball courts to the **Cenotaph by 11:00am**.
