## SOUTHERN GRAMPIANS PLAN FOR NATURE - HAVE YOUR SAY

Council is working to develop a Plan for Nature to set out strategies and actions to protect and enhance biodiversity and natural areas across the region. A survey and interactive map is currently open online for community to submit feedback.

- Identify high priority biodiversity/conservation areas on both public and private land for protection
- Identify the shortfalls in the Shire's planning scheme and required updates to protect these areas
- Review and prioritise the development or renewal of existing management plans for reserves that are now outdated
- Prioritise the focus for future Council investments in the protection of nature across the shire.
