Details of Garbage and Recycling Service

- 2020-21 annual service charge: \$360.00
- One 240 litre recycling bin (dark green base/yellow lid), one 120 litre garbage bin (dark green base/red lid) and one 240 litre FOGO bin (dark green base/lime green lid) will be delivered to your residence prior to or on the first collection date. Bins are the rate payer's property and responsibility.
- The cost of the bins is \$85.00 each and must be paid before the service can commence
- The collection charge is pro-rata and included on the Council rates notice. **New services will be charged from the start of the month following the date payment is made for the bin/s.**

Township Collections

Important Notes

- It is important that only appropriate materials are placed in each bin. A list of acceptable materials is provided below.
- The Contractor and Council will discontinue your waste service if bin contamination is an ongoing issue.
- The bin is your property, therefore lost and damaged bins (unless shown to be damaged by the contractor) are your responsibility.
- The bin is to be placed in a safe position that is easily accessible to the truck (i.e. not under or beside trees, not beside car or poles, etc).
- The bin lid opening should face the street.
- Do not overload bins - The maximum bin weight which can be lifted by the collection truck is 80 kgs.
- Residents in courts or cul-de-sacs may be requested to place their bins on the straight section of the road to allow collection.

Service Difficulties

Contact Council's Brown Street Business Centre on 5573 0444 if you have any service or damage issues. Council will endeavour to have bins missed by the Contractor picked up on the same day.

The cost of repairing or replacing kerbside bins that are stolen or damaged through normal wear and tear or ageing is incurred by the householder. However if your bin is damaged by the contractor's handling, the bin will be replaced or fixed at no cost to you.

RECYCLING BIN INFORMATION



Accepted in the RECYCLING BIN

Glass bottles and jars
Milk, juice and long-life cartons
Aluminium cans and trays
Steel cans and aerosols
Paint tins – empty tins ONLY
Plastic milk, juice, soft drink and detergent bottles
Plastic ice cream, margarine and take away containers
Pizza boxes – remove all food
Cardboard boxes - *Crush and tear all boxes to prevent jamming to max. size 50 x 50cm*
Newspapers and magazines
Letters, envelopes, cards & advertising material
Telephone books, work and school papers *Remove plastic covers and bindings*



NOT accepted in the RECYCLING BIN
