CORONAVIRUS (COVID-19) RESPONSE: UPDATE ON COUNCIL OPERATIONS

Due to recent restrictions as announced by the State Government, a number of Southern Grampians Shire Council service changes have been implemented.

SERVICE	OPERATION
Customer Service Centres Regulatory Services	Open.
Visitor Information Centres	Open.
Hamilton Gallery	Closed for ongoing works. Due to reopen August.
Hamilton Cinema	Open. Limited to 60 patrons.
Hamilton Library / Mobile Library	Open. Limited to 50 patrons. Children's programs remain on hold until further notice. Mobile library service resumes.
Hamilton Performing Arts Centre	Closed for ongoing works. Due to reopen July.
Hamilton Indoor Leisure and Aquatic Centre	Open. Density quotient of 1 person per 4sqm applies. Maximum venue capacity 150, including no more than 50 indoors. Maximum group size: 10 people indoors.
Hamilton Regional Livestock Exchange	Open. However access to weekly sales will be limited to buyers, stock agents, transport operators and Council staff. The general public will not be able to attend, even if they are sellers at the sale.
Home and Community Care Services (including Meals on Wheels)	Operating as normal.
Family Day Care and HILAC Occasional Care	Operating as normal.
Works Department	Operating as normal.
Maternal and Child Health	Operating as normal.
L2P Program	Operating as normal.
Transfer Stations (Hamilton and all towns) Kerbside Waste and Recycling Services	Operating as normal. See the Council website for all station opening hours.
Caravan Parks (Penshurst and Coleraine)	Open. Bookings permitted for single households plus two adults (plus their dependants). Not open to metro Melbourne residents unless they are permitted to be in Regional Victoria.

AMENDMENT C54SGRA AND C58SGRA

Planning and Environment Act 1987 SOUTHERN GRAMPIANS PLANNING SCHEME Notice of Approval of Amendment Amendment C54sgra and C58sgra

The Minister for Planning has approved Amendments **C54sgra** and **C58sgra** to the Southern Grampians Planning Scheme.

The Amendment comes into operation on the date this notice is published in the Victoria Government Gazette.

The amendments implement the findings of the Hamilton and Coleraine Flood Investigations by introducing planning controls that seek to improve the performance of the Southern Grampians Planning Scheme in responding to flood risk. The amendment modifies the Floodway Overlay (FO) and Land Subject to Inundation Overlay (LSIO) maps to more accurately identify areas within and around the Township of Coleraine that are affected by flooding, amends the schedules to the FO and LSIO and incorporates the Hamilton and Coleraine Local Floodplain Development Plan 2020 into the planning scheme.
