HAVE YOUR SAY - COMMUNITY LOCAL LAW NO 1 OF 2021

The 2021 draft Community Local Law has been endorsed by Council and is now out for community feedback.

The primary objectives of Local Laws are to protect the amenity of the municipality and the health and safety of the community. These objectives are not simply about compliance but are about creating an environment that is equitable and fair where residents, business and visitors alike, can participate in the community with mutual respect and enjoyment.

The draft Community Local Law will be available for public comment for a period of 28 days, with comments due by **COB Friday 10 September 2021**. On coming into effect, the Community Local Law No 1 of 2015 will be revoked.

PROPOSED LOCAL LAW - GOVERNANCE NO.1 OF 2021 AND GOVERNANCE RULES

Council has developed a proposed Local Law - Governance No.1 of 2021 in accordance with section 73 of the Local Government Act 2020 and have reviewed Council's Governance Rules in accordance with Section 60 of the Local Government Act 2020.

The objective of the proposed Local Law is to provide a mechanism to facilitate good governance of the Southern Grampians Shire Council. Its intended effect is to regulate the use of the Common Seal, provide for offences in the event of inappropriate conduct at Council Meetings and Delegated Committee Meetings, and for offences in relation to the misuse of the Common Seal and fraudulently signing petitions. On coming into effect, the Meeting Procedures Local Law No.10 of 2013 will be revoked.

At the Council Meeting held on 11 August 2021, Council resolved to exhibit the Governance Rules and proposed Local Law in accordance with Council's Community Engagement Policy.

Both documents will be available for public comment for a period of 14 days, with comments due by **COB Friday 27 August 2021**.
