

HAVE YOUR SAY - PENSURST ADAPTIVE WASTEWATER SOLUTIONS PROJECT

Penshurst community members are invited to attend a drop-in-session on **Tuesday 26 November 2019, 5:00pm - 7:00pm** at Volcanoes Discovery Centre for the Penshurst Adaptive Wastewater Solutions Project. Penshurst will be the focus of a case study looking at ways to improve the management of township sewage. Private septic systems are often inadequate or not effectively maintained which creates a significant risk to human health and the environment.

Wannon Water and Southern Grampians Shire Council are partnering in this Integrated Water Management project to engage the local communities and explore solutions.

SMART LIGHTING PILOT - MCGUIGAN LANE

McGuigan Lane, Hamilton, will be closed to all pedestrian access between **21 - 28 November 2019** for removal of four existing light poles and the installation of four new smart light poles as part of the Council's Smart Lighting Pilot.

The lights will enhance community safety at night by detecting pedestrian presence and have the ability to include CCTV cameras. The lights also have a reduced energy footprint and consume less energy without decreasing illumination.
