### GREATER HAMILTON LIBRARY REOPEN

### HAMILTON INDOOR LEISURE AND AQUATIC CENTRE (HILAC) REOPEN FOR SWIM AND SURVIVE PROGRAM

Following the announcement by the State Government on Sunday, HILAC is preparing to open its doors on **Monday 2 November 2020**, with a focus on resuming the Swim and Survive Program. With summer just around the corner, this is a great opportunity for young residents to recommence swimming lessons and learn this essential skill.

The Pool is restricted to those aged 18 years and under, with only one parent or guardian allowed per swimmer. Only 20 customers are allowed in each pool, and social distancing rules apply for those who are supervising their children.

Additional easing of restrictions will be applied subject to State Government advice.

### TRAVEL EXEMPTION TO PREPARE YOUR PROPERTY FOR FLOOD OR FIRE

Melbourne residents who own property in the Southern Grampians Shire can now apply for a travel exemption to Southern Grampians for the sole purpose of preparing their property for the flood and fire season.

If a travel exemption is approved, property owners will be provided with a letter allowing travel to the identified property within the Southern Grampians Shire for the sole reason of preparing that property as indicated on the form.

Letters of Approval will be issued for a maximum of 72 hours only (inclusive of travel time).

Please note that while property owners are in the Southern Grampians Shire, Metropolitan Melbourne Second Step restrictions will still apply.
