At the request of the Department of Environment, Land, Water and Planning, a public meeting will be held at 795 Morgiana Road Morgiana on **Thursday 26 March 2020** at **7.30pm**.

The purpose of this meeting is to receive nominations from not less than three or more than nine persons for appointment of a Committee of Management for the Morgiana Recreation Reserve Committee Incorporated for the next three year period.

KING STREET ROUNDABOUT CONSTRUCTION

Council would like to advise residents works will commence **Monday 16 March 2020** to construct a roundabout at the intersection of King Street and Shakespeare/Gordon Street.

The upgrade project has been funded by a \$260,000 grant received from the Federal Government's Blackspot Program, announced by Dan Tehan MP in July 2019.

For the duration of the works, Gordon Street and Shakespeare Street will be closed at the intersection of King Street. Traffic management will be in place along King Street, reducing King Street to one lane with traffic lights controlling traffic. Signed detours will be in place, directing traffic via either Mt Baimbridge Road, Kent Road, Park Street, Victoria Street or Horner Street.

Entry to and exit from the HILAC carpark will also be impacted by the works. Entry will be via the first driveway on Shakespeare Street (formerly the exit). The current entry on Shakespeare Street will be closed. Users will need to exit the HILAC carpark via the friendlies oval gate on King Street. The project is due to be completed by the **end of April 2020**, subject to weather conditions.
