It covers each of the standards and how you might apply them practically in your organisation. It is targeted at those responsible for the implementation of and compliance with Child Safe Standards in your organisation. This session may also be of value for those who are wishing to understand more generally the responsibilities of organisations in regards to Child Safe Standards.
