

PREPARATION OF BUDGET FOR 2019/20

In accordance with Section 129 of the Local Government Act 1989, the Southern Grampians Shire Council, at its meeting held on **24 April 2019**, resolved that the Budget presented to that meeting be prepared.

Section 223 of the Local Government Act 1989 provides that any person may make a submission on any proposal contained in the Budget or the declaration of rates and charges must do so in writing by **5.00pm on Monday 27 May 2019**. Submissions, should be addressed to:

Any submissions received will be heard at a Meeting of Council to be held in the Martin J Hynes Auditorium, 3 Market Place, Hamilton on Wednesday 12 June 2019 at 4.00pm.

Following this meeting, all submissions received in writing and in person, will be considered by Council.

Adoption of the 2019/2020 Budget and declaration of rates and charges for 2019/2020 will be considered at a Special Meeting of Council to be held in the Council Chambers, 3 Market Place, Hamilton on **Wednesday 26 June 2019**.

Submitters should note that Council is required to make available for public inspection submissions received in accordance with section 223 for a period of 12 months.
